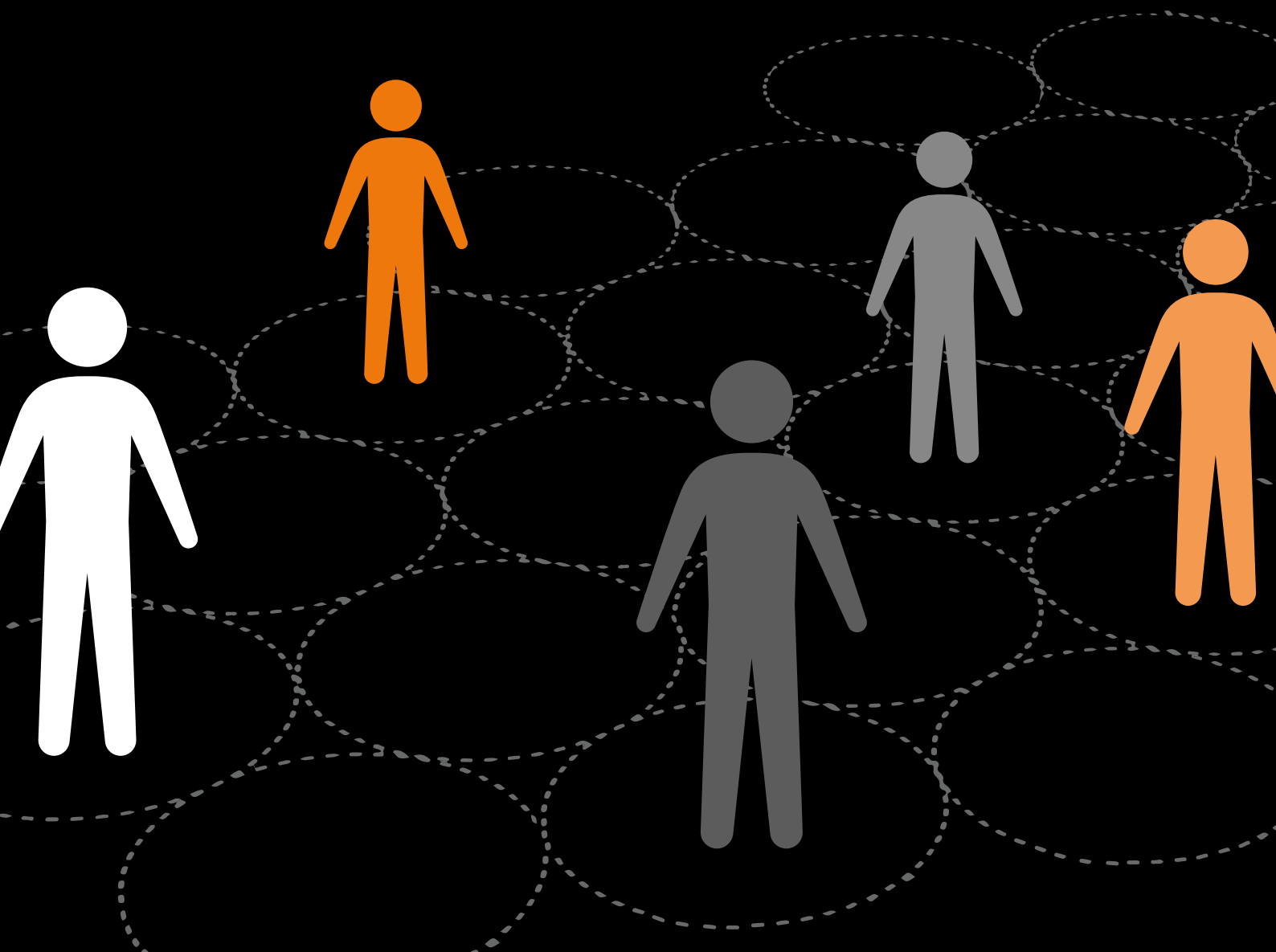

# KEEPING EVERYONE SAFE



In order to guarantee the health and safety of everyone participating in exhibitions, trade fairs and events, Reed Exhibitions Austria (RX) has compiled a list of the most important measures implemented to ensure all event participants can move safely around the exhibition centre.

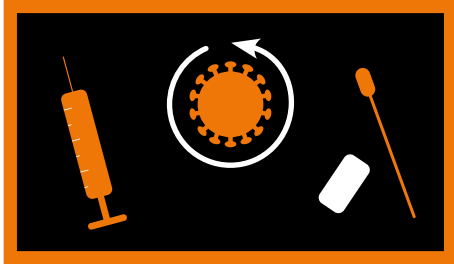
The measures are subject to on-going adaptation and – if necessary – augmentation, to comply with the current legal stipulations in place at the time of the fairs and events.

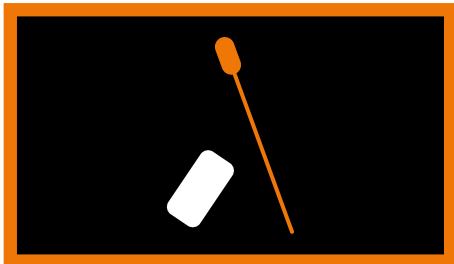
# VISIT SAFE –

## how we ensure safe passage of all participants around the exhibition centre



### G checks

Before being granted access, all individuals entering the complex – visitors, exhibitors, their booth staff and all people involved – will be subject to an obligatory G check (safety guarantees: Tested, vaccinated or recovered). The contact tracing will only be enforced if it is required by the legal regulations at the time of the event.



### Tests

At all our event locations the opportunity to be tested at a public testing site in close vicinity to the venue or at the entrance foyer directly, will be given.



### Masks

There is no obligation to wear a FFP2-mask or face covering during your stay, if legal stipulations permit at the time of the event.



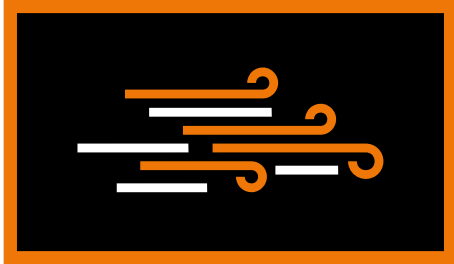
### Disinfection

There are hand disinfectant dispensers around the entire venue and in all toilets. Please use them regularly!

how we ensure safe passage of all participants around the exhibition centre



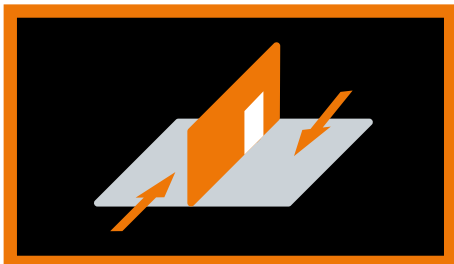
## Ventilation

Our powerful ventilation and air-conditioning systems guarantee a constant supply of fresh air in all indoor areas of the exhibition centre.



## Cleaning

Shared surfaces are cleaned particularly thoroughly to exclude the risk of contact infection.



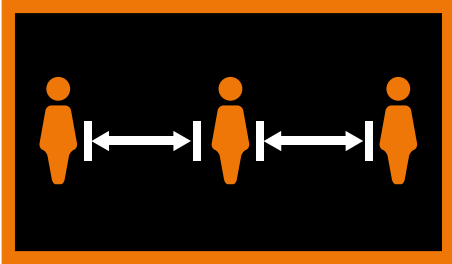
## Entrances and exits

Wherever possible, ingress and egress channels will be separated to prevent close contraflow crowd build-ups.



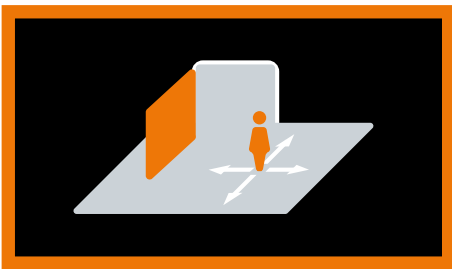
# MEET SAFE –

## how we ensure adherence to social distancing



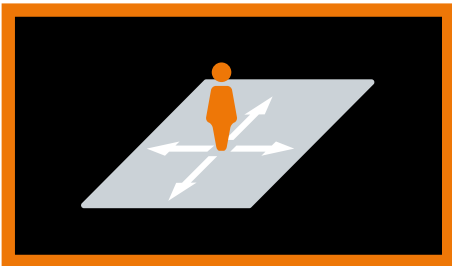
### Social distancing rules

Current legal directives do not prescribe an obligatory minimum distance. We have increased the number of crowd control staff, installed distance markers, protective plexiglass shields, information signage, routing signs, revised attendance limits, and are doing everything in our power to make the event as safe as possible for all participants.



### Safe hall planning

Booth spaces and crowd-flow routing has been planned to ensure participant safety and sufficient space to enable adherence to distancing rules.



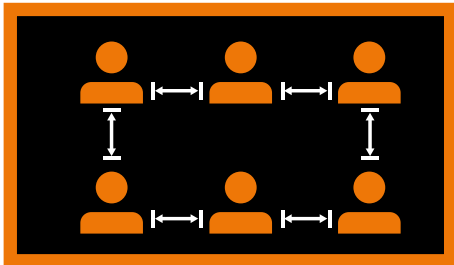
### Sufficient space in the entrance area

Entrance area arrangements are to be adapted to the respective fair and the expected volume of visitors. To ensure your safety, every foyer will be staffed with safety personnel and fitted with distancing markers.



# STAY SAFE –

## how we avoid crowd gatherings and bottlenecks



### Each crowd-flow junction is designed individually

We know exactly which areas are prone to jams, crowds, queues and bottlenecks (ticket windows, cloakroom, toilets, catering, information desks). Special precautions and arrangements will be made for these areas.



### Ticketing

Time spent in the foyers when entering the exhibition centre will be minimised by providing online ticket sales. Tickets can be loaded to mobile devices for contact-free admission.



### Tracing via the registration of all participants

All participants are registered through either the exhibitors or when purchasing a ticket. This enables us to facilitate contact tracing if a case of infection is discovered. The contact tracing will only be enforced if it is required by the legal regulations at the time of the event.



### Catering

All restaurants will be opened in compliance with the current statutory stipulations. Information about the provision of catering services at booths will be provided separately on our websites.

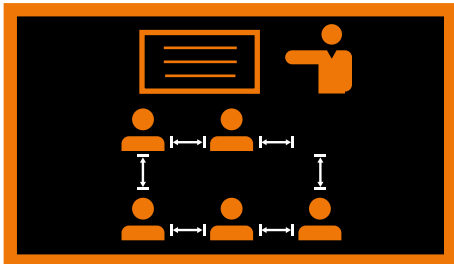

A wide range of digital options brings people together that can't be physically present at an event. Every show provides exhibitors and visitors with a wide range of digital expo participation options.



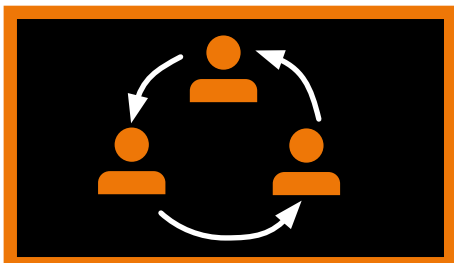
## Staff training
